

A proposal for cultural and travel itineraries for Slavonski Brod

a) On a half-day-trip basis

- Arrival to the main city square, near a path along Sava river.
- A walk with a tourist guide, with a short stop in front of the house of the world-known children's writer, Ivana Brlić-Mažuranić.
- An encounter with characters from Ivana's fairy-tales.
- A walk towards the Brod Fortress, the greatest monument of military fortification architecture of the 18th century in the South-Eastern Europe.
- A visit to the Ružić Gallery, which holds the first permanent display of Croatian Modern Arts of the second half of the 20th century, located in the south-western part of the Cavalier, occupying a gross area of 1.800 m².
- A broadcast of an 8-minute tourist video: "Once Upon a Time in the Brod Fortress: 18th century.
- The show takes place in the reconstructed home of the Fortress Commander, which is today occupied by the Elementary Music School. An encounter with some of the characters from the video after the show.
- A round of the fortification buildings with a tourist guide, including a climb onto one of the bastions in order to enjoy the gorgeous panoramic views, and the tour of the rooms in which the Fortress life went on.
- An encounter with a blacksmith in the Fortress blacksmith's shop, positioned inside the western fortress walls; a possible demonstration of the blacksmith's work.
- "A Living History": an interactive program with visitors' participation, an appearance of Fortress characters, such as the horsemen and members of the 18th century Slavonian Hussar Regiment, the Fortress Infantry, craftsmen and other characters, including Baron Trenk.
- A horse-ride or a coach-ride, taking photos etc. is on offer.
- Scenes of penalty administration to the fortress prisoners on the torture bench.
- A loud shot from the Fortress cannon.
- A visit to the Tamburitza Museum and the Chaplain's room, which is a part of the Tourist and Information Centre of the Tourist Board.
- Creative musical instrument-making workshops for wooden instruments (pipes) or an arranged demonstration of tamburitza-making craft performed by a plucked-instrument maker.
- Refreshments in the Town Hall in the Officer's Pavilion, with a sight of the life-size dummies dressed in the frontiersmen uniforms in the lobby; if agreed, a meeting with the City Mayor and other city officials.
- It is possible to make an arrangement to taste wines from the Chaplain's wine cellar.
- Lunch at some of the Slavonski Brod restaurants.

b) On a one-day-trip basis

- The first part of the trip as in a)
- A ride towards the Crljen family ethno-village in Podvinje.
- A tour of the village and lunch, with possible traditional social games from the 19th century Slavonia.

Option 1

- A ride to Brodsko Vinogorje.
- Sights of the Ivana Brlić-Mažuranić's summer residence.

Option 2

- A ride towards Poljanci. Making a tour of the estate, with possibility of riding in a coach or even horseback riding under the supervision of professional horsemen.

c) On an overnight-stay basis

THE FIRST DAY

- Arrival to Slavonski Brod in the afternoon.
- A ride towards the Ivana Brlić-Mažuranić's summer residence in Brodsko Vinogorje and the Crljen family ethno-village in Podvinje.
- A tour of the ethno village with additional activities.
- Return to the centre of the city.
- Dinner, possibly with a live tamburitza-band.
- A walk along Sava river to the Franciscan monastery.
- A view of the Monastery, including the Cloister, the Sacristy, the Refectory and the Library.

THE SECOND DAY

- Breakfast.
- Sightseeing of the central city square and the Fortress, as in a)
- A visit of the Milec family ZOO in the Ruščica village.
- Sights of the animals, taking photos of some animals under owner's supervision.
- Lunch at some of the Slavonski Brod restaurants.
- A ride from Slavonski Brod towards the western Brodsko Posavlje region.
- A short stay at Petnja lake in Sibirj area.
- The ride continues towards Brodski Stupnik, a well-known vine-growing region.
- A ride along the Stupnik Wine-Road, with possible wine tasting in the first Croatian Wine Hotel, owned by Zdjelarević family.
- A ride towards Slavonski Kobaš, a typical Slavonian village near Sava River. Its houses are built in a specific style, storks gathering on their roofs.
- Sightseeing of the Gothic Church of St Mathew and the Baroque Church of St John the Baptist.
- The ride continues towards Nova Gradiška.

There are no additional fees for such groups, who stay or have meals at Slavonski Brod and use at least two additional services, on the condition that a tourist guide is hired.
